2026 Kiko Goat Giveaway - Essay Challenge



What: This is a competitive essay challenge for youth in Coos, Curry, and Douglas Counties in Southern Oregon. Participants will have the chance to win a purebred (unregistered) Kiko doeling goat for the 2026 show season!

Up to four (4) January-born doelings will be awarded to top applicants for the purpose of showing in their respective County Fairs. Winners will be selected based on essay placement (1st through 4th).

How: Applicants are invited to write a 500–1,000 word essay describing their love of goats and why they would like to own and show a Kiko goat during the 2026 season.

Who: Eligible participants must be between the ages of 10–17, reside in Coos, Curry, or Douglas Counties, and be active in 4-H, FFA, or another organized youth goat program.

Essay Submission Period: February 1 – March 1, 2026

Winners Announced: March 14, 2026

Goat Pickup Dates: March 27 – April 12, 2026

Why: This Youth Incentive Program aims to encourage local youth to stay active and passionate about their goat projects while promoting awareness of the Kiko goat breed and its benefits to the community.

Kiko goats were developed from New Zealand's feral goats and are known for their ability to thrive in diverse climates and harsh conditions with little to no human intervention.

They possess a natural resistance to internal parasites, have excellent mothering skills and are capable of birthing and raising multiple kids without assistance.

Kikos are highly adaptable to various climates and environments, making them a versatile choice for farms in different regions.

They are a wonderful multi-purpose livestock option, providing milk, meat, brush management, pack animals and youth projects.
